

SUITIBILITY CHECKLIST

If none of the below apply to you, you are absolutely fine for treatment

- Are under the age of 18
- Are pregnant or breast feeding
- Have a history of keloid or hypertrophic scarring
- Have epilepsy
- Have Uncontrolled high blood pressure
- Have herpes virus
- Have problems with wound healing
- Have a pacemaker or heart condition
- Suffer from hyper-pigmentation
- Have an allergy to makeup, dye and /or pigment
- Suffer from telangiectasia (clusters of widened blood vessels)
- Have visible capillaries in the eyebrow
- Have taken Accutane or another strong retinoid in the past year
- Are diabetic (If so, you will require a doctor's note giving you clearance)
- Are undergoing chemotherapy (consult your doctor before booking in)
- Undergoing any treatment, taking any medication, or have any illness that compromises the immune system/healing
- If you are travelling to a sunny climate in less than 6 weeks. (PMU takes a minimum of 6 weeks to complete initial appointment and top up)
- Are taking any blood thinning medication (Warfarin, Coumadin, Heparin etc)
- Suffer from viral infections and/or infectious diseases. For example, Hepatitis, HIV, etc.)
- Have a circulatory disorder (If so, you will require a doctor's note giving you clearance)
- Suffer from any skin irritations, including eczema, impetigo or psoriasis near the treated area. This includes rashes, sunburn or acne
- Are sick on the day of treatment (For example with cold or flu etc.) and/ or have poor general health
- Blood disorders, such as haemophilia (impaired ability to make blood clots), sickle cell anemia/anemia, platelet disorder (puts you at risk for mild to serious bleeding)
- Have waxed your eyebrows in the last 2 weeks or had laser hair removal around the eyebrow in the past month
- If you have had Botox or filler around the area in the past 2 months
- Have had a skin peel, used AHA products and or/ used glycolic acid in the past month
